Don't you just love the parables of Jesus?

In Luke 15, Jesus shares three parables with us. Stories that many of us recognize immediately: 1) the parable of the lost sheep, of a man with a hundred sheep who lost one and left the ninety nine to find it; 2) the parable of a woman who had ten coins and lost one, searching diligently until she found it; and 3) probably the most memorable, the parable of the lost son or prodigal son, where a father with two sons had one who left and eventually found his way back home to the rejoicing of the father, but to a disgruntled brother. I had occasion recently to share this passage with one of our churches, and it reminded me again, what a loving, wonderful Father we have.

The context of these parables makes them even more meaningful and helpful in driving home the teaching Jesus shared. We see listening to Jesus that day, a group of tax collectors and notorious sinners, as well as a group of religious leaders, scribes and pharisees. The religious leaders publicly commented on the fact that they could not understand why Jesus would waste His time with these horrible sinful people. In turn, Jesus shared these parables to let those hearing know that every single one of them, tax collector and sinner, pharisee or scribe, were valuable to Him, and that Heaven rejoiced when even one these sinful people would come to the Father.

My heart was thrilled as I studied and taught through these truths again. You see, I have been that sinner, undeserving of spending time with Jesus, yet He offered me an opportunity to have that relationship with Him, in fact He died that I may have it. Then also, unfortunately, at times, I have been those in the religious crowd. One of those filled with pride and arrogance, forgetting how much the Father loves not only me, but those that are far away from Him. I have needed to be reminded how valuable each and every person is to the Father, and how He values a relationship with them every bit as much as a relationship with me. So, you see, I have been both the prodigal son that wandered away, and was welcomed home, and I have been that older son who stayed home and did everything I was supposed to but allowed it to fill me with pride. I lost touch with how to love like my Father, to be filled with joy when my lost family returns home, rather than pouting and complaining.

Guys, our state is the third-fastest growing state in the nation. Our county is predicted to double in size in the next twenty years. Many of those that are going to be coming here are not coming to join our churches. But they need our Jesus, and who is going to point them to Him? Let us not just see a beautiful story in the pages of Luke 15 but let us learn the lesson Jesus is sharing. May we see every single person as valuable, the way our Father does, and may we do everything within our power to bring them "home" to the rejoicing of Heaven.




